



## CET Admissions Policy and Procedures

CET seeks academically strong applicants who demonstrate seriousness, drive, and openness to the challenges and benefits of studying abroad.

CET programs are designed for degree-seeking undergraduate students who maintain an overall GPA of at least 3.0. However, applications are evaluated holistically, so no single component of an application is sufficient for admission or rejection. All applications are considered, so students with GPAs lower than 3.0 are encouraged to apply. Applications should reflect the student's academic goals, willingness and ability to embrace the challenges of living abroad, and interest in giving back to the host community.

Students apply to CET by completing an online application form and submitting supporting materials. Application requirements vary by program, so some programs may require supplementary materials such as a foreign language writing sample, visa application, résumé, or film/photography/studio art portfolio in addition to an official transcript and academic recommendation.

CET uses a rolling admissions process. Students are encouraged to apply and complete their application early to secure a place on the program of their choice. CET typically issues admissions decisions within two weeks of receiving the completed application and all required supporting materials. CET reserves the right to reject any application deemed of questionable merit, or to request additional information.
